The Great Wall is called 萬里長城(10,000 li long wall) maan6 lei5 coeng4 sing4 in Chinese or often just 長城 coeng4 sing4.

(2) 長江大橋 coeng4 gong1 daai6 kiu4

The Chinese language doesn't show singular/plural. So it's a bit difficult to know if the textbook is referring to the many bridges across the Yangtze River or perhaps 'the' most famous bridge at Nanjing.
